- Treasurer's Report given by Shari.
- Wanda Morrow gave a brief report about their May show at The Preserve.
- Lisa introduced a new member, Sue Morgan.
- Fall show schedule discussed. November 20<sup>th</sup> show will be held at Wind Drift Farm. December 4<sup>th</sup> show will be in Williamston at the Ag. Center.
- Canter for the Cure show discussed by Jackie. Everything was reported to be on schedule. Volunteers will be contacted by e-mail.
- Dressage 101 information shared by Patricia Hooten. A form for demo riders and a registration form will be posted on the website.
- Jean Luc Clinic in October has one ride paid for by Pam and Melissa. A motion was made by Jen to raffle off two rides for the clinic. Patricia seconded the motion. The motion carried. Patricia Hooten will print and collect the raffle tickets. The price for each ticket will remain at \$10.00.
- Jackie shared that a letter had not been composed for non-member ads. Pam suggested that the cost for non-member ads should be \$25, which is the cost of a membership. This will enable the person to join the club and advertise for free. Then a motion was made by Wanda that **ONLY** members should be allowed to post ads on the website and

in the newsletter. Catherine seconded the motion. A vote was held and the motion passed.

- Most Active Member Award was discussed by Patricia. A need for volunteer hours was needed from The Preserve show.
- NCDCTA's interest in possibly holding an educational event in the eastern part of the state was briefly discussed.
- A Harvest Moon fundraiser possibility was introduced by Jackie.
- July meeting will be a pool party in Morehead City. The date for that is July 12<sup>th</sup>.
- August 30<sup>th</sup> at The Mongolian Restaurant in New Bern was decided on for the August/September meeting.
- October 4<sup>th</sup> meeting will be held at Mary Ann's house.
- Ad rates in newsletter were discussed. Chrystal suggested \$15 for quarter page, \$25 for half page, and \$40 for full page. Paula made a motion that the current rates be adjusted to these amounts. The motion passed and these are the new ad rates for the newsletter.
- Budget for Dressage 101 was brought up by Patricia. Kris is charging \$300. The cost for the lunging sessions was also discussed and not determined. A \$500.00 budget, which is to include food, was discussed and a motion made by Jen. The motion was passed.
- Awards Banquet for next year was discussed with a possible change in venue. It was suggested that everyone think about possible locations and return with ideas.
- Melissa brought up some issues from The Preserve regarding the mailing of score sheets. Also, it was brought up that riders cannot school the SHV course before their ride. The fact that the scores for the SHV class at the Preserve show were not posted. Wanda said that the scores may be on the back of their score sheets. These scores

locations will be determined and then Wanda will send them to Libby for posting. The fact that SHV is now a year-end award, the score-keeping responsibility at shows was brought up. Melissa suggested that this responsibility needs to be thought about and discussed by the club in the case that she is not involved in the SHV portion of a show. Melissa said that she would continue with her part as she has done in the past. Jackie suggested that the show organizer for the next show that includes SHV discuss the scoring responsibilities and details prior to the show.
